Weather: Mostly cloudy with patchy light rain from around dawn. The afternoon becomes mostly dry with occasional bright spells developing.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% in the morning 60% in the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Very good visibility outside any low cloud. Some cloud down to 600-900m, particularly during the morning. Cloud bases lifting above the summits from late morning.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Fresh winds will give a cold feel on higher tops.

Forecast for Sunday 07 Aug 2022

Weather: Cloudy with the risk of some patchy light rain during the morning. The afternoon will be mainly dry with increasing bright spells.

Maximum wind: West 20 gusting 35 across higher summits, gradually easing.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% increasing 60% from mid-afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Visibility very good outside any low cloud. Cloud base 700-900m during the morning, lifting above most peaks during the afternoon

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 8 Celsius to plus 16 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 7 Celsius rising to plus 11 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
