General Situation

Low pressure will move in from the west with various associated frontal systems running across the United Kingdom over the next couple of days bringing unsettled weather and strong winds to most, however southeastern locations will fair best.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low over the Faeroes moves northeast as a cold front clears north of Shetland early Saturday. A ridge of high pressure then builds over the UK, drifting north over Shetland later Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 4 later in south.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in west.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 02 Apr until 0600 UTC on Sunday 03 Apr:

Southwest 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or 4, then east 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in west.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

South to southeast 3 to 4, occasionally 5 mid channel this morning and overnight, becoming locally variable 1 to 3 near the normandy coast this afternoon.
Smooth or slight, perhaps occasionally moderate mid-channel.
Risk of showers especially from early evening.
Good, locally moderate in any showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 3 to 5, veering south to southwest Sunday evening.
Slight with swell, perhaps occasionally moderate mid-channel.
Isolated showers, more frequent for a time Sunday afternoon.
Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
