General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over the United Kingdom will weaken slowly as a complex area of low pressure develops over France and the southern half of the United Kingdom during Friday and Saturday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 in north for a time.

Slight or moderate becoming rough, occasionally very rough in north later.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4 increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north later.

Smooth or slight, increasing slight or moderate later.

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 2 or 3 becoming variable 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers later.
Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5 in west later.
Slight, increasing moderate west of Lands End later.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming northerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 in northwest later.
Smooth or slight, increasing moderate in west later.
Fair.
Mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming northerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.
Smooth or slight, increasing moderate in west.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4 becoming northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Smooth or slight increasing slight or moderate.
Showers.
