General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will maintain unsettled conditions across the whole of the United Kingdom for the next few days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less at first in Moray Firth, otherwise westerly or southwesterly veering northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight until later in east, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly veering easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South backing east, then becoming cyclonic later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers, then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, mainly east or southeast, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, mainly southeast, backing east for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Mainly slight.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southeast veering southwest, then northwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers for a time.

Mainly good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly south, 3 or 4, becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.
Showers for a time.
Mainly good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, mainly easterly veering southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time in north.

Occasional rain or thundery showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeasterly at first, 3 or 4, becoming southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or thundery showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Thundery showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, veering southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, veering west 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing southwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight east of the Lizard.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, veering west 5 or 6, then decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight in far east, otherwise moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight, except in far southwest.

Showers.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming westerly 5 or 6 later.

Smooth at times near shore, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming westerly 5 or 6 later in south.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in south.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic at first in north, otherwise westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate at first in south, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing northeast, then becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, then becoming southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, then northwesterly later in north and in southeast, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in northwest.

Smooth or slight in North Channel, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in northwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5 at first in northeast, otherwise northwesterly 5 to 7, backing westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate or rough in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly becoming cyclonic 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, mainly in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming northwesterly, then backing southwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northern North Channel.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North becoming cyclonic later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, mainly north or northwest, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly or northeasterly, 4 or 5 in north, 6 or 7 in south.

Smooth or slight at first in central areas, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north, becoming smooth or slight south of skye.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly veering northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly, 4 at first in north, otherwise 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in far south.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low north of Faeroes passing north. Further low tracking north across Scotland into Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil in force.

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in south
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest
Showers at first
Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 05 Jun until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 05 Jun:

Southwesterly 4 or 5 at first in north, otherwise variable 3 or 4, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5 in south
Slight or moderate
Occasional rain
Good, occasionally moderate or poor

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or variable 2 to 3, locally 4, becoming southwest to west 4 to 5 this evening, locally 6, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight, veering west to northwest later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight to moderate for a time this evening.

Showers or rain, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, becoming isolated by evening.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 3 to 4.

Slight, with a low swell.

Isolated showers.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

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
