General Situation

The British Isles will remain within a southwesterly flow of air, between high pressure to the southeast, and low pressure to the northwest. Pressure will build across southern and eastern parts on Monday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure near Iceland will maintain a strong south-westerly flow over Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southerly gale force 8 expected soon.

Southwest 5 to 7 gradually easing 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 05 May until 1800 UTC on Sunday 05 May:
Southwest 4 or 5 becoming south or southwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, but very rough in the far west later.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 to 4, locally 5 in the north at first, decreasing 1 to 3 by dawn,
becoming variable.

Slight to moderate, becoming smooth or slight overnight.

Risk of patchy drizzle in the north at first mist or fog patches forming
overnight.

Good, becoming locally moderate to very poor overnight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming mainly southeast by dawn.

Smooth or slight with a low swell at first.

Risk of fog patches, mainly in the north.

Good, perhaps locally poor or very poor.

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
