



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Temperatures will fall quite sharply under clear spells between showers this evening and overnight, likely leading to some icy patches forming, especially where further showers occur during the early hours of Saturday.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **23:00 on Fri, 05th Jan 2018** until **08:00 on Sat, 06th Jan 2018**

Icy patches are expected to develop overnight, most likely on untreated roads, pavements and cycle paths. There is a chance that injuries could occur from slips and falls on icy surfaces.
