Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 05 December to 0000 UTC Tuesday 06 December 2011

General Situation

Low pressure near western Norway and high pressure near the Azores will maintain a run of cold showery westerly or northwesterly winds across the British Isles. Small, but intense low pressure systems moving southeastwards in the flow may bring severe gales or storm force winds to northeast Scotland on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times, becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough in east, rough or very rough in north.

Squally wintry showers, snow possible later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9, perhaps storm 10 for a time, becoming variable 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in east, very rough, occasionally high in north.

Squally wintry showers, snow later in far north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, backing southwesterly 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Mull of Kintyre.
Squally wintry showers, snow at first in far north.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest, veering north later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.
Squally wintry showers, snow later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in south, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far south, but variable 3 or 4 at first in north.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far north and far south.
Squally wintry showers, snow for a time later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north, backing southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in north, backing southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in far north and far south.
Squally wintry showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A wintry airflow has become established across the Northern Isles. A polar low will move east across Orkney during Monday afternoon and another southeast across Shetland during Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Gale now ceased but northwesterly gale force 8 expected soon, issued 0948 on Monday.

Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 in south later.
Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in east.
Occasional wintry showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Dec until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 06 Dec:

Westerly or northwesterly becoming cyclonic for a time in south, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.
Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in east.
Squally wintry showers, perhaps a longer spell of snow in south.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 6 to 7 with some gusts to 45kt, backing northwest to west by afternoon.
Rough, locally very rough.
Scattered squally rain or hail showers.
Moderate to good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 40kt.
Rough.
Scattered showers.
Moderate to good.

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
