Forecast for Saturday 04 Sep 2021

Weather: An overcast day with cloud sitting on the summits during the early hours. There may be a spot of drizzle at first, but it will turn dry as the cloud will steadily lift and thin during the morning. There is a small chance of some cloud breaks in the west, but on the whole it will remain a cloudy afternoon and evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: 40% increasing to 90%

Visibility: Poor on the summits with cloud base 300-400m, steadily improving through to good as the cloud lifts.

Forecast for Sunday 05 Sep 2021

Weather: A mostly cloudy day but brighter than Saturday and feeling milder. Sunny spells at times during the afternoon and staying dry. Breezy during the morning but winds will ease later in the day.

Maximum wind: South-easterly 15-18mph gusting 25mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: 70% increasing to 100%

Visibility: Possibly poor in the east at first with cloud base 400m. Improving to very good during the morning.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 12 Celsius increasing to 22 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 12 Celsius increasing to 18 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
