Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Tuesday 04 June to 0600 UTC Wednesday 05 June 2019

#### General Situation

A large area of low pressure to the north of Scotland will continue to slowly move away to the north today, with another low crossing from the southwest. This will maintain the risk of strong winds and some rain or thundery showers in many areas.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough until later in north.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

##### 24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing east or southeast, then becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Showers, then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeast 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

South, backing east or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, then veering south 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain for a time.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Mainly good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, backing southeast 5 or 6, then veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Rain or thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northwest 4 or 5 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers later.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later in north, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, veering southerly 3 or 4, then veering southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Occasional rain or thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.

Thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south 3 or 4, then veering southwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or thundery showers, fair later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, veering west or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, veering west or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Showers.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, veering southwest, then veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing northeast, then becoming cyclonic, mainly south, later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering west 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing northwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain, becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic then northeasterly, then backing northwesterly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in far north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic then northerly or northeasterly, 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeast 4 or 5, then increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, but 6 or 7 at first in south.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later in south.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, but 6 or 7 at first in south.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Tuesday 04 Jun 2019 at 0600 UTC until Tuesday 04 Jun 2019 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep low centred near the Faeroes will fill north during Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:  
Southwesterly gale force 8 at time of issue.

Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 in south  
Moderate or rough  
Showers dying out  
Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 05 Jun:  
Variable 3 or 4, but southwesterly 5 or 6 at first in north  
Slight or moderate, but rough at first in northwest.  
Fair then rain later  
Good, occasionally moderate or poor later

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable or southeasterly 1 to 3, locally 4, perhaps locally 5, veering southwest to west and increasing 4 to 5 late afternoon, locally 6 until late evening, decreasing 2 to 4 overnight.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight to moderate in the evening.

Showers then a longer period of rain from mid morning, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, clearing early afternoon to isolated showers.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest to west 2 to 4, veering west to northwest by midday.

Slight, with a low swell.

Isolated showers.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

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
