#### General Situation

High pressure covering the United Kingdom will slowly decline and move away eastwards, as an area of low pressure moves northeastwards towards the Southwest Approaches.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, moderate north and west of Orkney.

Drizzle for a time in north.

Good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough, occasionally smooth at first.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeasterly, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate.

Fair then rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Fair then rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southeast 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later near St Davids Head.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, veering south 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later near St Davids Head.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East, veering south, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at first.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 5 or 6 later.  
Smooth, becoming slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or southeast, veering south, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at first.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Fair then rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 3 or 4, then backing east 5 or 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 , then veering south or southwest, then backing southeast 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in south.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 4 or 5, backing east 5 to 7 for a time.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Fair then rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 4 or 5, backing east 5 to 7 for a time.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Fair then rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East, veering south or southeast, 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first.  
Fair then occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest, backing southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.  
Rain or drizzle at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.  
Fair then occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest, backing southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or drizzle at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Fair then occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Sunday 04 Oct 2015 at 0000 UTC until Sunday 04 Oct 2015 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover the Shetland basin on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southwest backing south 3 or 4.  
Moderate but slight in shelter east of Shetland.  
Showers at times.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 04 Oct until 0000 UTC on Monday 05 Oct:

Southerly 3 or 4 backing southeasterly 3 or 4 occasionally 5 later in southwest.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers at first, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming south to southeast 3 to 4 around dawn, increasing 4 to 5 by midday, then 6 to 7 by early evening, perhaps gale 8 mid channel.

Smooth or slight, increasing moderate to rather rough in the afternoon, perhaps rough later.

Some fog patches near the french coasts around dawn rain by Sunday evening, locally heavy.

Good, locally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 6 to 7, decreasing 5 to 6 around dawn, further decreasing 4 to 5 Monday evening.

Moderate to rather rough, perhaps rough at first, decreasing mainly moderate with a low swell later.

Rain in the north at first, then isolated showers developing.

Good, locally moderate in rain or showers.

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
