



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A trough of low pressure is expected to continue to focus heavy showers across the region, giving 30-50 mm of rain quite widely across the area, with more than 70 mm locally.

The Met Office have issued an **Amber Warning of Rain**

Valid from **10:00 on Sun, 05th Aug 2012** until **03:00 on Mon, 06th Aug 2012**

Slow moving, heavy showers through the day and into the night time period are likely to cause flooding in places. The public are advised to be prepared for the risk of disruption from surface water flooding.
