General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will decline away to be replaced by low pressure, becoming centred to the northwest of Scotland by tomorrow afternoon.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later west of Orkney.

Moderate or rough, but smooth or slight in Moray Firth.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time in far west.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high around Orkney for a time, but slight or moderate in Moray Firth.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough west of the Lizard peninsula.

West or northwest 3 or 4, backing southwest 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough west of the Lizard peninsula.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Southwest, veering west later, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough west of St Ives Bay.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest at first, veering westerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, veering westerly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first north of Morecambe Bay.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first north of Morecambe Bay.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5.

Mainly moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 6 or 7 for a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in North Channel.
Showers then rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, backing southerly 6 to gale 8 for a time.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.
Showers then rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 6 to gale 8 for a time.
Rough or very rough, becoming high for a time.
Showers then rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A wave depression will move rapidly northeast over Norway. An Atlantic depression will move east to the south of Iceland.
