Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Thursday 01 June to 1200 UTC Friday 02 June 2023

#### General Situation

High pressure remains slow-moving over the northeastern Atlantic during the next couple of days. As a consequence settled conditions will prevail across the United Kingdom, although strong northeasterly winds will continue to affect some southern areas, especially the Strait of Dover.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near Cape Wrath, veering east or southeast 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate to the north and west of Orkney and near Rattray Head, but elsewhere smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate at first to the north and west of Orkney and near Rattray Head, otherwise smooth or slight.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

The northerly airstream over Shetland Waters eases, with high pressure still dominant.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

North or northeast 3 to 5

Moderate, but slight in sheltered waters near Shetland
