Forecast for Saturday 06 Feb 2021

Weather: Extensive low cloud expected throughout the day, with snow at times across ranges north of Inverness to Torridon. South of this it will be mostly dry, some brighter skies across Skye and the west coast.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 20%. Some breaks likely across Skye and the west coast

Visibility: Poor in widespread low cloud down to 500 to 700 metres and in any falling snow or drifting snow. Very good outside of cloud in the far west of the area.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Fresh snowfall will be drifting around. Icy surfaces possible in the north.

Forecast for Sunday 07 Feb 2021

Weather: A few snow showers across Caithness and more northern parts of Easter Ross and Sutherland, otherwise dry with plenty of sunshine.

Maximum wind: Gusting 30 to 40 mph on the higher summits. Severe wind chill.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Generally very good with great air clarity. Visibility briefly dropping poor in any snow, and down to 550 metres in any snow showers that pass by.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 4 rising to zero Celsius.
At 800m: Minus 4 Celsius
Freezing level: 200 metres or less
