Weather: Low cloud will affect western ranges south of An Teallach down to Skye until early afternoon, this then breaking up to allow brighter skies. Chance of a little light rain here in the morning too. Elsewhere it will be a dry day with some bright or sunny intervals.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 70%

Visibility: Poor in low cloud down to 500 metres across the southwest during the morning, otherwise cloud mostly above summits

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Risk of sunburn in any prolonged sunshine. Feeling chilly under cloud cover at height.

Forecast for Saturday 05 Jun 2021

Weather: Dry in the morning with some sunshine. Sunny periods in the afternoon and the chance of a few heavy showers.

Maximum wind: Southerly 15 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Generally good with good air clarity, occasionally dipping in showers

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 rising to 19 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 11 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
