General Situation

Pressure will remain high across the United Kingdom during the next couple of days, bringing mainly settled conditions.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Rattray Head and later near northeast Orkney.

Mainly smooth in inner Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering northwesterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east and near Cape Wrath.

Mainly smooth in inner Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain at times, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, but mainly variable 2 or 3 in Firth of Forth.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast becoming variable, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight.

Fog patches developing in far north, otherwise fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in far north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 2 or 3, backing north or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches in far north, otherwise fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in far north.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, backing northerly 2 or 3 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near headlands, becoming variable 2 or 3.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in Bristol Channel, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

East or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Lands End.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Variable mainly east, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later in north.

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming north 3 or 4 later.

Moderate at first in north, otherwise smooth or slight.

Rain later in north, fog patches later in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in east.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeasterly except in Firth of Clyde, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming northwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight.
Rain later in north.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Mainly south or southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near islay and Tiree.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional drizzle later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near islay and Tiree, becoming variable 2 or 3, then becoming north 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or drizzle at times.
Moderate or good.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
South backing southeast, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Occasional drizzle later.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast, veering southwest, 4 or 5, then veering northwest 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Rain or drizzle at times.
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
South backing southeast, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.
Mainly moderate.
Occasional drizzle later.
Moderate or good.

South or southeast, veering southwest, 4 or 5, then veering northwest 3 or 4.
Mainly moderate.
Rain or drizzle at times.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Ridge of high pressure extends west from Baltic across much of UK. However, occasional troughs will extend from the northwest, these pushing across Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly backing southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in northwest.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first in northwest. slight east of Shetland.
Occasional light rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Thursday 04 Sep until 1200 UTC on Thursday
04 Sep:

Southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in east.
Moderate. slight at first east of Shetland.
Occasional light rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 for a time later this afternoon and
evening.

Slight.

Mist patches, mainly on Thursday.

Moderate, locally poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast 3 to 4, backing northeast to north for a time in the
afternoon, decreasing 2 to 3 on Friday.

Slight.

Mist patches, mainly on Friday.

Moderate, locally poor at times.
