Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 04 June to 1200 UTC Tuesday 05 June 2018

General Situation

High pressure will remain slow moving to the north of the United Kingdom with a complex area of low pressure to the south. This will maintain the gentle northeasterly airflow for the next few days. However, a cold front embedded within this flow will spread fresher air southwestwards, clearing the sea fog from most northern and eastern areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in northwest.

In north, slight or moderate, in east, smooth or slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest.

Moderate or rough at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

North veering northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate or rough becoming moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Fog patches then fair.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good.

North or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

Occasional drizzle later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fog banks, fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight, occasionally moderate later.
Fog banks in north, fog patches in south, becoming fair later.
Moderate to very poor, occasionally good in south, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.
Smooth at times in sheltered west, otherwise slight or moderate.
Fog patches.

Smooth or slight close inshore, otherwise slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.

East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.
Smooth or slight close inshore, otherwise slight or moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Smooth at times in lyme bay, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers at first, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.
Smooth or slight in lyme bay, otherwise slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northerly veering easterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Smooth or slight in east and near coast of south Wales, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers at first, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Smooth or slight in east and near coast of south Wales, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly north or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in north.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 at time in north.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate at times in north.

Fair.

Good.

Isle of Man

Northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in north.

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Showers at first, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Variable, mainly easterly or northeasterly, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

Variable, mainly north, becoming southeast later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.
Showers at first, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Variable, mainly east or southeast, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times later in south.
Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 at times in south, otherwise easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times later in south.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 at times in south, otherwise easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Ridge of high pressure to north combining with a complex low across southern Scandinavia to keep a North-NE flow across the area.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east
Slight or moderate
Fair

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east
Moderate, becoming rough in east

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 4 to 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 to 4 guernsey northwards for a time this afternoon and evening.

Slight to moderate.

Scattered showers with a risk of thunder mist or fog patches.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 6, decreasing 3 to 4 by midnight, occasionally 5 until dawn.

Slight to moderate, perhaps locally rather rough until early Wednesday morning.

Scattered showers becoming less frequent in the afternoon, with a risk of thunder risk of mist patches at times.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor.

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
