**Weather:** Clear skies overnight and a sunny start to the day. Patchy cloud then feeding in from the west, with the best of the prolonged sunshine in the east. Lower cloud pushing in late evening.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

**Forecast for Saturday 03 Jun 2023**

**Weather:** Scattered low cloud in the north and west through the early hours and to start on Saturday, this mostly clearing by mid-morning. A little low cloud perhaps lingering in the far north but otherwise dry with sunny spells. Best of the sunshine towards the Great Glen. Low cloud in the north pushing southwards during the evening.

**Maximum wind:** Mostly light, north to northeasterly 10 mph later.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 60% at first, improving to 80% for most of the day. 60% again later in the evening.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Good or very good visibility outside of cloud. Scattered low cloud, base 600-800m, at first, mostly clearing through the day, broken low cloud returning from the north in the evening.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 9 rising to plus 15 in the north and plus 19 Celsius in the south.  
**At 800m:** Plus 5 rising to plus 12 Celsius.  
**Freezing level:** Above summits.
