General Situation

High pressure will remain slow moving to the north of the United Kingdom with a complex area of low pressure to the south. This will maintain the fairly gentle northeasterly airflow across many areas during the next 48 hours.

Easterly or northeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 in south.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Ridge of high pressure to the northwest and area of low pressure across southern Scandinavia maintain a NE flow across Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east
Moderate, occasionally rough in east, but locally slight near southwest coasts

of Shetland

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 06 Jun:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, perhaps 6 at first in east
Moderate, perhaps rough at first in east, but locally slight near southwest coasts of Shetland

Channel Islands - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 4 to 5, occasionally 6, and gusty near showers, decreasing 2 to 4 overnight, occasionally 5 south of jersey.
Slight to moderate.
Mist or fog patches scattered showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, becoming isolated this evening.
Good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 2 to 4, locally 5 south of jersey in the morning, backing northerly in the evening, decreasing 1 to 3 by morning.
Slight, occasionally moderate in the morning, with a low swell.
Isolated showers, with a risk of thunder, becoming more frequent in the evening risk of mist patches.
Good, occasionally moderate to poor.
