Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Friday 02 October to 1200 UTC Saturday 03 October 2020

#### General Situation

Deep low over the English Channel will move west then away into Biscay, with a further low to the northwest of Scotland. This will bring unsettled conditions with gales or severe gales in southern areas.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later in northeast, but becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4 at first in west, otherwise easterly or southeasterly 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in east.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing north, then veering east later, but becoming variable at times, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight in west.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in west, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, backing northerly for a time, 4 or 5.

Moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly, veering southeasterly, then backing easterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly, backing northeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, becoming cyclonic

4 or 5 later.  
Moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic, becoming southeasterly, veering southerly or southwesterly later, 4 or 5.  
Moderate, occasionally slight in south.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly backing northeasterly, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough in south.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in south.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, then becoming southeasterly 3 to 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeasterly, becoming variable 2 to 4, becoming westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, backing east 4 or 5, then north 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8, then variable 2 to 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first, then becoming slight at times.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 2 to 4, becoming northwest backing west or southwest, 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
North or northeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, then decreasing 5 at times.  
High at first in far west, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 6 to gale 8, backing west or northwest 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight east of the Lizard, becoming very rough later in far west.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:

North backing northeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first.  
Slight at times in Bristol Channel, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 6 to gale 8, backing northwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 or perhaps severe gale 9 later.  
Moderate or rough, but slight at first in northeast, occasionally very rough later in west.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing northerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in south.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in north.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing northwesterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6 later in north.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.  
Rain.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing northerly, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing northwesterly, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south, becoming northeasterly 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Occasional rain becoming fair.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast, backing north later, 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 6 or 7, occasionally 5 at first, veering northeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 at first in north, otherwise northeasterly, backing northwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far north.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times, becoming easterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight, perhaps very rough for a time in far north.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 at times in north, otherwise northeasterly, backing northwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times, occasionally 4 in north, becoming easterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough at times in North Channel, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in north.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming west or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 to 6, veering north 6 to gale 8, veering east 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time in west.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in west, becoming northerly or northwesterly 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later near skye.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 2 to 4, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering northeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 in south.

Smooth at first near skye, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in west, becoming northerly or northwesterly 2 to 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 2 to 4, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering northeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 in south.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in south.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Friday 02 Oct 2020 at 1200 UTC until Saturday 03 Oct 2020 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure moves west of Shetland with pressure building on Friday, low moves from south towards Shetland waters on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Southeasterly severe gale force 9 decreasing 8 imminent. Issued 21:46 UTC Thu 1 Oct 2020

Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in the south.

Rough becoming moderate.

Occasional rain

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in the south

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 03 Oct until 1200 UTC on Saturday 03 Oct:

Southeast 5 to 7

Moderate becoming rough in the south.

Mainly fair, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South to southeast 7 to severe gale 9, backing east 4 to 6 by dusk, then backing north to northwest by midnight, then becoming cyclonic and increasing 7 to gale 8 for a time in the west of the area.

Rather rough to rough, occasionally very rough in the north and far west, decreasing moderate with a low swell in the east of the area during the evening, then increasing rather rough to rough later in the west of the area.

Rain at times, some heavy, possibly thundery.  
Moderate to poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in the far west of the area, becoming northwest 6 to gale 8 by mid evening, backing west 5 to 6 by mid morning.

Moderate at first in the east of the area, otherwise rather rough or rough, increasing very rough for a time in the southwest into the evening, decreasing moderate to rather rough overnight.

Rain for a time, then showers, some heavy, possibly thundery.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
