General Situation

Moderate or poor occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south or southwest 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers and fog patches for a time.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

East 5 or 6, veering southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south or southwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

Isle of Man - (SWW)

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

East veering southeast, 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time in north and south.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 or 6, veering southeast 4 or 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight later.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure will drift eastwards to the north of Shetland and the surrounding waters. A low complex will move northwards to the west of the UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil in operation at time of issue.

Variable, mainly east or northeast, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Wednesday 02 Apr until 0000 UTC on

Thursday 03 Apr:

Variable, becoming east or southeast, 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to southeast 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 in the evening, then variable 1 to 3 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in the north and west.

Isolated thundery showers, becoming more frequent later.

Moderate to good, locally poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming mainly westerly 2 to 4 by dawn.

Slight.

Thundery showers, with mist and the risk of fog patches, clearing early to mid-morning.

Moderate to poor, perhaps very poor, becoming good.

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
