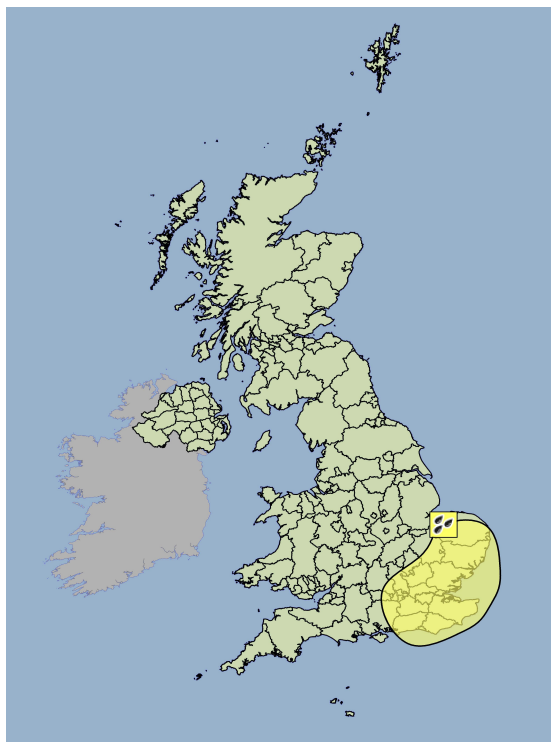




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A deeply unstable airmass will cover southeastern areas of England on Monday. The main risk of disruptive downpours is now early this morning, with only a very low risk during the afternoon period. These heavy showers and thunderstorms may become focused into slow-moving narrow bands, meaning that whilst some areas experience locally intense downpours giving 25 mm within an hour and very locally 40 mm within 2 to 3 hours, adjacent areas could stay dry.

Please note that as well as expanding the warning area, the likelihood has also been increased to low of significant impacts.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **03:10 on Mon, 28th Jul 2014** until **23:45 on Mon, 28th Jul 2014**

Heavy thundery showers are expected across parts of East Anglia and southeast England, including the London area, at times on Monday.

Isolated thundery downpours are now developing over East Anglia, extending further north into Norfolk, thus the extension to the warning area. These will become more widespread across East Anglia and southeast England by morning, dying out for a time later in the morning, before further isolated heavy showers and thunderstorms develop again in the afternoon. There is also a risk of heavy rain affecting the far southeast at times later today and into Monday night.

The public should be aware of the risk of localised flooding, especially if the downpours affect urban areas.
