for the period 1200 UTC Monday 01 June to 1200 UTC Tuesday 02 June 2020

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure remains dominant over much of the United Kingdom during the next couple of days. An Atlantic front will approach northwest Scotland on Tuesday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northeast 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast, 3 to 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Smooth at first in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fog patches, occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable at times, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly south, 2 to 4, becoming north or northeast 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly east at first, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north, 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, backing north later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near Gibraltar Point.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, backing northerly later but becoming variable later in Thames estuary, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near North Foreland.

Fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northerly, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches developing later near North Foreland.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later near North Foreland.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first near North Foreland, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first near North Foreland.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or northeast 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate offshore, becoming smooth or slight later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northerly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly north, 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate in far southwest, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in far west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5

later in west.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers later.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Variable, mainly north, 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, mainly north, 2 to 4, becoming north 4 to 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.  
Showers later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

Variable, mainly north at first, 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwest 4 or 5, then veering northeast 5 or 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.  
Showers later.

Southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.  
Smooth or slight.

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, then veering northerly or northeasterly later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.  
Occasional rain and fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure over the Northern North Sea will gradually decline, allowing a cold front to approach from the northwest on Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southerly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later in west.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in west and becoming smooth in sheltered waters

just east of Shetland.  
Fog patches  
Good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun:

Cyclonic 2 or 3 at first in east, otherwise northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in north and west but smooth in sheltered waters just east of Shetland at first.  
Fog patches. Rain in west later.  
Good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 3 to 4, locally 5 until around midnight, locally northwesterly near the french coast in the morning.  
Smooth or slight with a low swell at first, perhaps occasionally moderate in the north and west at first.  
Fair or fine.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 to 5, locally variable 1 to 3 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Isolated showers developing by midday Wednesday.  
Good, locally moderate later.

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
