#### General Situation

A humid airstream will bring fog patches and showery rain at times, particularly in eastern areas. Meanwhile a ridge of high pressure will continue to build across western areas tonight, bringing increasingly fine conditions here.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches, occasional drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, but mainly moderate in north.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later near Rattray Head.

Fog patches at first in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, becoming variable at times, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near Rattray Head.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast becoming variable, 2 to 4.

Slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then north or northwest 3 or 4 for a time later.

Slight, becoming smooth at times later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers, perhaps thundery in south, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 at first in north, otherwise southwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 2 to 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers, rain and fog patches later.  
Good, occasionally poor, or very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly, becoming variable for a time, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in east.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, veering northerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in east.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West veering northwest for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally smooth.  
Rain or showers later in east.  
Good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or showers at first in east.  
Good, occasionally poor at first in east.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time.  
Slight or moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southwest, 2 to 4.  
Slight or moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in Bristol Channel.  
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in Bristol Channel.  
Slight or moderate, but smooth or slight in east.

Occasional drizzle later in west.

Good, occasionally poor later in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

West backing southwest 3 to 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time in north and west.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, but variable in Liverpool Bay, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west.

Slight becoming moderate for a time.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in west.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional drizzle in west.

Good, occasionally poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
- (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in the North Channel.  
Slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Good occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in the North Channel.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Mainly good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast veering south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional drizzle later in west.  
Good, occasionally poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 to 6, but variable 3 or less at first in north.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in north.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 to 6, but variable 3 or less at first in north.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Thursday 03 Jun 2021 at 1800 UTC until Friday 04 Jun 2021 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia with ridge extending across Shetland Waters maintaining a southeasterly airstreamt

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southeast 3 or 4

Slight but moderate in the west at times

Fog patches

Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Friday 04 Jun until 1800 UTC on Friday 04 Jun:

South or southeast 3 to 5

Slight or moderate

Fog patches

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 2 to 4 becoming northwest to north overnight then northwest to west later.

Smooth locally slight, with a low swell at first.

Rain at times, mainly in the southeast overnight, perhaps locally heavy.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fine.

Good or very good.
