Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Sunday 02 June to 0600 UTC Monday 03 June 2019

#### General Situation

Atlantic low will slowly track northeast across northwestern Scotland through Sunday, then will drift north towards Faeroes on Monday, with another low moving north into the Irish Sea on Tuesday. Generally a mainly strong southwesterly flow is expected with showers across most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic, then south or southwest, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in southeast and northwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south or southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in the firths.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in northeast and smooth later in southwest.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 to 5, veering southwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4, veering southwest 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate later offshore.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 to 6, decreasing 3, backing southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4, veering southwesterly 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northeast.

Showers, perhaps thundery, becoming fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, veering southwesterly 4 to 6, then veering westerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 or 4, backing southwesterly 4 or 5, then southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time, backing south 4 or 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later in west.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in west.

Fog patches, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South, veering southwest, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 5 or 6, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Smooth or slight becoming moderate or rough.  
Rain or showers becoming fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 3 or 4, then southeast 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in north.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, veering southwesterly 5 to 7.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.  
Rain or showers becoming fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.  
Rain or showers later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South, veering southwest, 5 to 7.  
Moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Rain or drizzle becoming fair.  
Moderate or poor becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 4 to 6, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough for a time.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 to 7, backing south, becoming variable, 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in southeast.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in the North Channel.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic, then southwest, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, veering northwest later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate in east.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, veering southwest, 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic, then southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 near Cape Wrath, veering westerly 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north and south.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, veering southwest, 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic, then southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally rough in southwest.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 near Cape Wrath, veering westerly 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Troughs of low pressure will continue to extend northwards across Shetland Waters over the next 24 hours

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

East or southeast veering south 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time

Moderate occasionally rough in east later

Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 02 Jun until 0600 UTC on Monday 03 Jun:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5 occasionally 6 in east later  
Moderate occasionally rough in east  
Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches.  
Good, occasionally poor or very poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southerly to southwesterly 3 to 4, occasionally 5 in northwest, becoming variable 3 or less jersey southeastwards for a time this afternoon, veering westerly to northwesterly this evening.  
Smooth or slight, becoming mainly moderate in northwest this afternoon.  
Fog patches, becoming fog banks for a time in north this morning rain at times from late morning, clearing by midnight.  
Good, becoming poor or very poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly to southwesterly 3 to 4, occasionally 2 at first, becoming variable 3 or less around midday, then becoming southerly to southwesterly 3 to 4 overnight, occasionally 5 by dawn in far northwest.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far northwest, with a low swell.  
Isolated showers.  
Good.

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
