



## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

High pressure keeps things quiet and dry but has once again allowed some quite widespread and dense fog to form. At this time of the year, the sun should clear most of the fog by around 9 to 10 am.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Fog**

Valid from **04:40 on Sun, 13th Mar 2016** until **10:00 on Sun, 13th Mar 2016**

Areas of fog have once again formed quite widely across the southern half of England. Some of the fog is dense, with visibilities in the range 50 to 100 metres, and may take until mid-morning to clear locally. Please be aware that this may impact any early-Sunday travel plans and make for difficult driving conditions.
