Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry for many with some brightness and hazy sunshine as cloud thickens from the west. Light rain may spread into Northern Ireland and the western Isles of Scotland by dusk and it will feel a little colder. Remaining cold but mostly dry and cloudy overnight with a frost, and rain spreading further into northwest Scotland. Windy across southern parts.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Dry for many on Thursday with some good sunny spells developing. Occasional rain, sleet and snow is expected to spread across Scotland though, and then into the rest of England and Wales on Friday. Winds easing but remaining chilly in places.
