Confidence: Confidence is high for showers to persist through Friday and for a time on Saturday, although confidence in detail is moderate or low. The transition over the weekend to high pressure dominating the weather has high confidence, and with it the dry and settled weather into the new week.

Headline for Friday 01 Jul 2022: Sunny spells and scattered, locally heavy, showers. Turning drier later.

Forecast for Friday 01 Jul 2022

Weather: A mostly dry but rather cloudy start to the day. Some sunny spells will quickly develop, along with scattered showers. The showers will be heavy at times, especially towards the middle of the day. However, they will be lighter and less frequent than on Thursday. The showers then easing into the evening with late sunny spells developing.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90% chance for most of the day, but 40% in the early hours over western slopes before early cloud lifts and clears.

Low cloud and visibility: Early cloud on western slopes will bring poor visibility at times above 400m. Otherwise, generally good or excellent, but reducing to moderate in showers, or poor in heavy showers.

Meteorologist's View

Isolated wind gusts could be 5-10mph higher than stated in the table when accompanied by heaviest showers. Showers are likely through much of the day, so ensure you are properly equipped to deal with the conditions and are aware of potentially slippery surfaces.

Forecast for Saturday 02 Jul 2022

Weather: An early band of rain will clear shortly after dawn. A day of sunny spells and scattered showers then follows. The showers will be lighter than previous days. Rather breezy to start the day, but winds easing through the afternoon.

Maximum wind: 15-20mph with gusts 30mph at first. Easing to 10mph, gusting 20mph by late afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 30% chance, mainly on eastern slopes until mid-morning with cloud bases 350-450m. Then 80-90% chance through the afternoon with only the odd shower cloud obscuring the tops for a time.

Low cloud and visibility: Early cloud bringing poor visibility (especially on western slopes) until mid-morning above 350m. Good or excellent in the afternoon, temporally reducing to moderate in showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** 8 increasing to 18.
At 600m: 6 increasing 10.
Freezing level: Above summits.
