for the period 0600 UTC Wednesday 01 July to 0600 UTC Thursday 02 July 2015

#### General Situation

A hot and humid southerly airflow will bring sporadic thundery showers northwards across the country through Wednesday and Thursday. Fresher and more settled conditions will develop across western areas later on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 at first in far northwest, otherwise southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers later, fog patches later in northwest.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight at first.

Thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Thundery showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Thundery showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering southwesterly 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Thundery showers and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, becoming cyclonic for a time, 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight.

Thundery showers and fog patches at first, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers and fog patches, later in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southwest, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers and fog patches at first, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Thundery showers and fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, backing east later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.

Thundery showers at first, then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight later in east.

Thundery showers and fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, backing southeast later, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers at first, then fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers and fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest, backing southeast later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.  
Thundery showers at first, then fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southwest 4 or 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.  
Thundery showers, fog patches later in north.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.  
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 5 or 6, veering south or southwest 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers, fog patches later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.  
Thundery showers and fog patches at first, then fair.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly veering southerly, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 in northwest.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Thundery showers and fog patches later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4 until later in northwest, otherwise southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in east.  
Thundery showers until later, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less at times in Firth of Clyde.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.  
Thundery showers and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in Firth of Clyde.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Thundery showers until later, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in northwest.

Thundery showers and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Thundery showers until later, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Thundery showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest, then backing southeast later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers until later, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north 4 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Thundery showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest, then backing southeast later, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers until later, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Wednesday 01 Jul 2015 at 0600 UTC until Wednesday 01 Jul 2015 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High over the Baltic and low to west of UK, maintaining a warm, showery, southerly airflow across the area.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

South or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first.

Moderate occasionally rough later.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Wednesday 01 Jul until 0600 UTC on Thursday 02 Jul:  
South or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers, occasionally heavy with risk thunder.  
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 to 5, veering westerly early afternoon, becoming variable 1 to 4 late evening, then southerly again by Thursday morning.

Slight, locally moderate in the north and west at times.

Isolated thundery showers fog patches spreading in from the west of the area early afternoon, clearing during the evening.

Mainly good, locally poor or very poor in the afternoon and evening.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or southerly 1 to 3.

Mainly slight with a low swell.

Isolated thundery showers, clearing in the afternoon risk of further showers Friday morning.

Moderate to good.

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
