Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Saturday 01 June to 1800 UTC Sunday 02 June 2019

General Situation

A warm and moist southwesterly airflow will persist across most areas during the rest of today, before an area of low pressure moves towards the British Isles during Sunday, bringing the risk of strong winds. The associated cold front will also bring cooler and fresher conditions.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly backing southeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in east, becoming variable 3 or less later in west.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain, becoming fair for a time, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in west, otherwise southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, then veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in Moray Firth, then occasionally rough later in east.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in south.

Mainly fair then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far north.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, veering south or southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in north.

Rain at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, veering southwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Rain at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times at first, then occasionally 6 later.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, perhaps thundery, later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.
Thundery showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southerly or southeasterly, then veering southwesterly later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, perhaps thundery, later, otherwise mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far west.
Thundery showers at first.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.
Mainly fair, then occasional rain and fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor, but occasionally very poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Occasional rain with fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, mainly in west.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in east, then occasionally rough later in far west.
Fog patches developing, rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times in far west.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable for a time in east, veering southerly or

southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, mainly in west.
Smooth or slight until later in far east, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough later in west.
Occasional rain and fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming south or southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, then occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches developing, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.
Moderate, occasionally rough.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5, then veering southwest 5 to 7.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough later.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.
Moderate, occasionally rough.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 3 or 4, veering south 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate occasionally rough later.
Occasional rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 6 or 5 occasionally 7 at first.
Moderate or rough.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, veering southwest 5 to 7 later.
Slight or moderate.
Fog patches until later in southeast, occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor, but occasionally very poor in southeast until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time, then decreasing 4 at times later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Occasional rain, fog patches until later in North Channel.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor, but occasionally very poor until later in North Channel.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time, then decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time later, then veering southwest 5 to 7 later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.

Rain at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing easterly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth for a time in central areas.

Rain at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic, then southwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time, mainly in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing easterly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Rain at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic, then southwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time, mainly in south.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Saturday 01 Jun 2019 at 1800 UTC until Sunday 02 Jun 2019 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure and associated weather fronts will affect Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil at time of issue.

Southwesterly but cyclonic at first in north, 3 or 4, backing southeasterly 4 or 5

Slight or moderate

Occasional rain, drizzle and mist. Fog patches.

Good, occasionally poor or very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 02 Jun until 1800 UTC on Sunday 02 Jun:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6

Moderate, occasionally rough in north

Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor or very poor

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 2 to 4, but locally variable this evening, becoming south to southwest overnight, then southwest 4 to 5 in the north and west of the area from mid-morning, perhaps 6 in the afternoon, locally variable 1 to 3 in the south.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in the northwest of the area in the afternoon.

Isolated mist and fog patches becoming more extensive across the west and north of the area by the morning showers from late morning.

Good, occasionally poor or very poor, especially in the west and north of the area.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 2 to 4 in the southeast of the area, otherwise southwest 4 to 5, veering generally westerly 4 late evening, backing southwest 3 to 4 by dawn, locally variable 2 or 3 in the afternoon.

Slight, occasionally moderate in the north and west of the area until midnight, with a low swell.

Occasional rain or showers and mist or fog patches, becoming fair overnight with isolated showers.

Moderate to very poor, becoming good overnight.

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
