Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 04 November to 0000 UTC Tuesday 05 November 2019

General Situation

An area of low pressure currently centred over Ireland will drift southeastwards to lie across northern France by Tuesday morning. This low will bring unsettled weather to all parts with gales in places. A col will then develop across the United Kingdom by late Tuesday, bringing a brief quieter interlude.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East backing northeast, 5 to 7.

Rough, occasionally very rough in southeast and moderate in shelter.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6, backing north 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate later.

Showers, perhaps wintry at times later.

Mainly good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 to 6, backing northeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 later in north.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, but 7 or gale 8 at first in south decreasing 4 at times later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough, then moderate later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly backing northeasterly, 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 later in north.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly, 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise 6 to gale 8, backing northerly 4 to 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, backing north or northeast later, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in north.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate at first in south, otherwise moderate or rough.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming northerly or northeasterly, 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.
Smooth at first near Thames estuary, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in north.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic later, 4 to 6, increasing 7 at times.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming northerly or northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at times.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate for a time.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming north, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, then northerly later, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time in west.
Rough or very rough west of the Lizard, otherwise moderate or rough, but slight or moderate northeast of Berry Head.
Showers, occasionally thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 5 to 7, decreasing mainly 4 later.
Rough or very rough until later in far southwest, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming cyclonic, then north later, 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far southwest.
Showers, occasionally thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time in west, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west, becoming slight or moderate later in east.

Showers, occasionally thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, mainly southwesterly at first, 3 to 5, becoming northeasterly 5 or 6 later, occasionally 7 later in far northwest.

Mainly smooth until later in far northeast, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough near St Davids Head, and later in far northwest.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in west, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northeasterly 4 to 6, then backing northerly 6 or 7 later, perhaps gale 8 later in north.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east 4 or 5, then backing north or northeast 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 7 or gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6, then 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.

Rain at first.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in east, decreasing 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later. Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6, backing northeasterly 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in North Channel.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough at first in North Channel, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 to 6, increasing 7 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in sheltered east.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 6, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering east 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 6 or 7.

Moderate or rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Showers, occasional rain in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering east 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north, then becoming smooth or slight later in south.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 6 or 7.

Rough, occasionally moderate.

Showers, occasional rain in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering east 3 to 5 later.

Mainly rough, becoming moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low across UK slowly sinks southwards and maintains a brisk easterly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northeast 5 to 7

Rough

Occasional rain at first in south

Good, occasionally moderate at first in south

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Nov until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Nov:

Northeast 5 to 7

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later in south, decreasing 4 at times tomorrow evening, then veering northerly 5 to 6 in far northwest.

Moderate in shelter, otherwise rather rough to rough, occasionally very rough tomorrow afternoon, decreasing slight to moderate tomorrow evening in north.

Rain at first in far east, heavy at times, then showers becoming frequent and heavy, perhaps thundery by mid-morning.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 to 6, becoming north 5 to 7 by mid morning, decreasing 4 during the evening in west.

Rather rough to rough, occasionally very rough at first in west, becoming moderate with swell during the evening.

Scattered, sometimes heavy showers, locally thundery at first, becoming isolated.

Good, occasionally poor.

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
