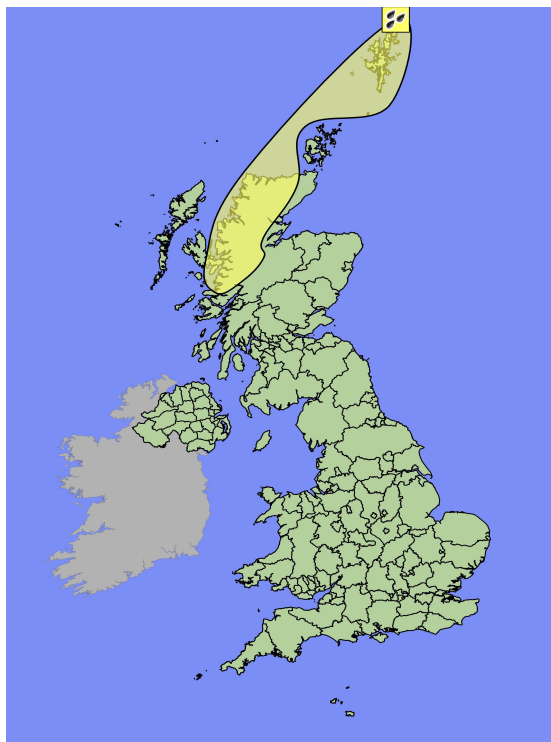




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A slow moving low pressure centre to the northwest of Scotland will produce some heavy, slow moving thundery showers, these merging at times especially across Shetland. Hourly totals of 10-15 mm are expected with more than 20 mm locally. Totals across Shetland could exceed 60 mm by the end of the day.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **10:00 on Wed, 22nd Aug 2012** until **21:00 on Wed, 22nd Aug 2012**

Thundery showers will develop during today and become heavy and slow moving, with some localised torrential downpours possible. More persistent rain is expected over Shetland, adding to already wet conditions here.
