Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Be prepared for sunburn and dehydration on long hikes.

Forecast for Friday 02 Jul 2021

Weather: Chance of some thin low cloud across the northeast at first, this soon burning off. Otherwise a mainly dry day with some good spells of sunshine. Small chance of an isolated afternoon shower in the south.

Maximum wind: Southerly 15 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 80%

Visibility: Generally good, little in the way of cloud on the Munros, although some haziness in the air

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 4 rising to 22 Celsius

At 800m: Plus 12 Celsius

Freezing level: Above summits
