for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 04 August to 1200 UTC Monday 05 August 2019

General Situation

Low pressure centred to the west of Ireland will bring rain or showers to most areas during the next couple of days, especially in the west and north where the showers will turn thundery at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 in far north.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Cape Wrath.

Showers later, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north, becoming smooth at times in Moray Firth.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4 becoming southwest 3 to 5.

Slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 to 5.

Slight.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 2 to 4 veering southwest 3 to 5.

Slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 to 5.

Slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 2 at first.

Slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, veering southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in south.

Showers, mainly in north.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 3 in north.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery for a time in north.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, veering southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming moderate.

Mainly fair, but isolated showers later.

Moderate, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, perhaps 7 at first in east.

Slight becoming moderate.

Showers for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 to 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight, becoming moderate.

Mainly fair, but isolated showers for a time.

Moderate, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 to 6.

Moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 to 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near the Isles of Scilly.

Showers.

Moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 to 6.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate later in lyme bay.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 to 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in shelter.
Showers for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate.
Showers, thundery at times.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near great orme head.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South veering southwest, 4 to 6.
Smooth or slight at first in Liverpool Bay, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at times.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, perhaps moderate later.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.
Smooth or slight in north, but moderate at times in east.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally variable 2 in north.
Smooth or slight in far north, but elsewhere slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at times.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel.
Smooth or slight in shelter, but moderate at times in North Channel.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 2 to 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Firth of Clyde.

Showers, thundery at times.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 to 5, decreasing 2 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly southerly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Showers, thundery at times.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 to 5, decreasing 2 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 in far north, becoming cyclonic 2 later in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery in south.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first in far north, then becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Weak ridge of high pressure will decline during Monday with a trough of low pressure approaching from south.

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later

Slight becoming moderate in north later

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 2 to 4, occasionally variable 1 to 3 jersey southward, backing southwest 4 to 5 overnight, locally 6, mainly mid-channel, then veering westerly 3 to 5 by midday.

Slight, occasionally smooth in the south, increasing slight to moderate overnight, perhaps briefly rather rough mid-channel later.

Occasional mist and local fog patches risk of rain or showers this afternoon and rain or drizzle Monday morning.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor, perhaps locally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 5, backing southwest 4 to 5 overnight, locally 6, mainly mid-channel.

Slight to moderate, occasionally rather rough mid-channel overnight, with a low swell.

Some rain, drizzle and mist, with a risk of fog patches, clearing early afternoon to isolated showers, perhaps locally heavy with thunder in the north later.

Moderate to poor, perhaps locally very poor, becoming mainly good early afternoon.

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
