Pressure will remain high near the faeroe islands maintaining a rather variable easterly or northeasterly airflow across the United Kingdom.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure to the north or northwest will maintain a Northeasterly airstream over Shetland and the surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil in operation at time of issue.

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east.

Moderate or rough.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:

North or northeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Fair.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 1 to 3, occasionally 4, locally variable at times, becoming north to northeast Sunday evening.

Smooth or slight.

Fair to cloudy risk of mist patches.

Good, perhaps occasionally moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards by mid morning, backing north to northwest by Monday evening.

Smooth or slight with a low swell developing.

Risk of mist or fog patches isolated showers by evening.

Moderate to good, perhaps poor or very poor at times.

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
