Forecast for Tuesday 06 Jul 2021

Weather: A dry morning with some sunny spells. A few showers developing this afternoon, but many hills seeing a dry day. Low cloud and patchy rain spreads west into Caithness after dusk.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 80-90%.

Visibility: Good or very good. Overnight low cloud, mainly across northern ranges, will lift above the summits by dawn. Cloud lowering to around 500-600m across the north of Caithness after dusk.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Moderate UV levels.

Forecast for Wednesday 07 Jul 2021

Weather: Low cloud and patchy rain spreads south through the early hours and early morning, although the Cuillins and Knoydart staying dry with some clear then sunny spells. Most ranges becoming dry by mid-morning, but a few showers in the afternoon, these merging to give more occasional light rain and low cloud later in the day and through the evening.

Maximum wind: Northwest 10-15 mph, occasionally gusting 20 mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30% in the morning, but 80% across hills in the south of the area. 10% or less from late afternoon.

Visibility: Very good outside of any low cloud. Cloud bases 500-700m in the morning across Skye and the mainland further north, but above the summits further south. Cloud may lift above the summits briefly around the middle of the day, but becoming extensive above 500m across all ranges late afternoon, with bases to low levels along the west coast.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 12 Celsius rising to 18 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 8 Celsius rising to 12 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
