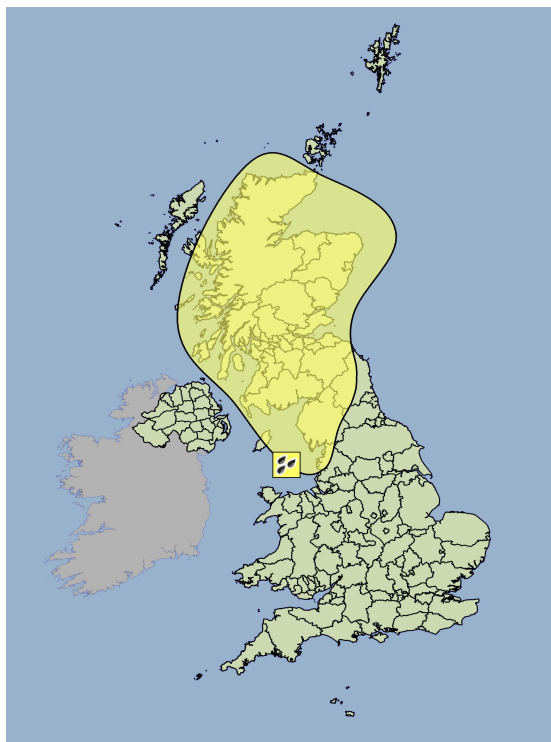




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A low pressure area will move north across Scotland on Sunday. Rainfall totals will be very variable but could well exceed 50 mm in 12-24 hours in places, whilst winds are likely to gust 40-50 mph over some coasts and hills. Computer models are still showing some variations in the track and depth of the low, with consequent uncertainty regarding extent and amounts of rain and in the timings of the improvement from the south - this alert is likely to be updated again.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Rain**

Valid from **00:15 on Sun, 03rd Aug 2014** until **23:00 on Sun, 03rd Aug 2014**

An area of persistent and at times heavy rain will move north across the area. Additionally strong winds will affect many areas for a time, with the risk of gales over some coasts and hills. Conditions should improve quite quickly over northern England, with some improvement expected for parts of southern and perhaps central and eastern Scotland as the persistent rain moves away. However, further scattered thundery downpours may then affect parts of eastern Scotland.

The public should be aware of the risk of localised flooding and of disruption to transport and outdoor activities.
