General Situation

With pressure now falling, occasional thundery rain is expected at times on southern coasts, whilst a weakening cold front will bring rain at times to northwestern areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less at times in the Moray Firth and near Cape Wrath, otherwise southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in the Moray Firth.

Occasional rain in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Moderate until later in northwest, otherwise smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5 at times in south.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in south.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.
Fair.
Good, occasionally moderate until later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, decreasing 3 at times later in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming variable 3 for a time in west.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in east.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 with sea breezes for a time, becoming northeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Thundery rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times, becoming northerly 5 or 6 later near St Davids Head.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in west.

Thundery rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in the Bristol Channel and near lundy island, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate until later in west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain at first.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northeast 5 at times, occasionally 6 later except in Cardigan Bay.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in west.

Thundery rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less at times in Cardigan Bay, otherwise northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming northerly 5 for a time near Mull of Galloway.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or northeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, backing northerly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time later in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in the North Channel.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in the North Channel.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in the North Channel.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northwest 4 or 5 except in good shelter, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth in good shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 in good shelter, otherwise north or northwest 4 or 5, then decreasing 3 at times.

Smooth in good shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5 in south.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain and fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain and fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 01 Jul 2018 at 0600 UTC until Sunday 01 Jul 2018 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure across Shetland waters will decline later on Sunday as a weak trough of low pressure crossing from the west on Sunday night.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southerly 4 or 5 occasionally 6 in west
Slight or moderate
Fair
Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 01 Jul until 0600 UTC on Monday 02 Jul:

Southerly 4 or 5 veering westerly 3 or 4
Slight or moderate
Fair but rain for a time
Good becoming moderate or poor for a time

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 5, perhaps 6 mid channel at first, becoming northeast or variable 2 to 4 by late morning, occasionally 5.

Slight to moderate, decreasing smooth or slight towards evening.

Scattered thundery showers, becoming less frequent this afternoon risk of mist or fog patches.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in any mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 to 4, occasionally 5, increasing 4 to 5 towards evening, perhaps locally 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, soon increasing slight to moderate Monday morning, with a low swell at first.

Isolated thundery showers risk of mist or fog patches.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in any mist or fog.

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
