Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Monday 01 June to 1800 UTC Tuesday 02 June 2020

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will remain dominant over the next 24 hours. An Atlantic front will then approach northwest Scotland on Tuesday, before bringing occasional rain and showers across all parts on Wednesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northeast 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming variable, then becoming north later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Occasional rain at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

East or southeast, becoming variable, 2 to 4.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Easterly or northeasterly, backing northerly, but becoming variable later in the Thames estuary, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near North Foreland.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northerly, 3 or 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later, occasionally 6 at first in east.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor later in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5 later in east.

Smooth or slight.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure over the Northern North Sea will continue to decline, allowing a cold front to sink southeast on Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5.

Slight, increasing moderate in west and becoming smooth in sheltered waters east of Shetland.

Fog patches, rain later in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun:

Variable 2 or 3 at first in far southeast, otherwise northerly veering northeasterly 4 to 6.

Moderate or slight, but smooth at first in sheltered waters east of Shetland.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 to 4, locally 5 until around midnight, occasionally northwesterly near the french coast from late morning on Tuesday.

Perhaps moderate in the north and west at first, otherwise smooth or slight with a low and decreasing swell.

Fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Isolated showers developing by midday Wednesday.

Good, locally moderate later.

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
