




Yellow warning Rain

21:00 Sat 2 Jun 2018



Heavy showers and thunderstorms are expected to develop late morning, lasting through the afternoon before easing late evening.


What to expect

- Homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Fast flowing or deep floodwater is possible, causing a danger to life
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures and where flooding and lightning strikes occur, there is a chance of delays and some cancellations to train and bus services.
- Some communities may be cut off by flooded roads
- Possible power cuts and loss of other services to some homes and businesses

Further details

Heavy showers and thunderstorms are expected to develop by late morning on Saturday across inland parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland. Some of the storms could be severe, and with generally light winds, will be slow-moving. Whilst some areas may escape with a dry day, where storms do develop some torrential downpours are possible. There is the potential for 20-30 mm of rain to fall in an hour, and as much as 50-70 mm in 2-3 hours. As well as heavy rain, frequent lightning and some large hail are also possible.
