Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Thursday 02 June to 0000 UTC Friday 03 June 2016

#### General Situation

Low pressure over the near Continent will bring strong winds and occasional rain or showers to eastern parts of the United Kingdom on Thursday. High pressure centred to the northwest of the British Isles will maintain largely fine and settled weather over the west and north.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later in southeast.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, decreasing 3 at times in southeast.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later, becoming variable 3 at times in Firth of Forth.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far south.

Fair then drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in Firth of Forth, otherwise northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Moderate, becoming slight later.

Rain or drizzle at times, fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming slight later.  
Rain or drizzle at times, fog patches developing later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or drizzle at times, fog patches at first.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or drizzle at times, fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near North Foreland, decreasing 4 at times in west.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times in east.

Occasional rain, becoming mainly fair for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5, but 6 at first near North Foreland, backing northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first near North Foreland.

Rain or drizzle at times, fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or showers at first.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east, becoming variable later.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Lands End.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first near Lands End.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times later in south and east.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5 at first in north, otherwise variable 3 or 4.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

North or northeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeast 5 at times in Solway Firth.

Northeasterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 except in far north.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Cape Wrath.  
Occasional rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in north, then becoming variable 3 or 4 at times later in south.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Cape Wrath.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Low over France extends troughs northwest over Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northeast 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Thursday 02 Jun until 0000 UTC on Friday 03 Jun:

Northeast 5 to 7.  
Rough, occasionally moderate in south.  
Occasional rain clearing south later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands
