Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 01 November to 0600 UTC Saturday 02 November  
2019

#### General Situation

Further spells of wet and windy weather can be expected today, as a deepening low approaches from the Atlantic. The deep low is then expected to move eastwards across the middle of the United Kingdom during Saturday, bringing severe gales to the Bristol Channel, English Channel and the north of Scotland.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 to 6, backing east 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 6 to gale 8, backing northeasterly 7 to severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 to 6, backing east 5 to 7 later.

Moderate, becoming rough later near Rattray Head.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north, backing northeasterly later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near Rattray Head.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6, then southeast 3 to 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough later offshore.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, veering southwest later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at times, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 6 to gale 8, then veering south 4 to 6 later.

Moderate, becoming rough for a time offshore.  
Fair at first, then rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, veering southerly or southwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.

Rain at times, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, backing southerly 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 for a time in east.

Moderate or rough.

Fair at first, then rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 to 6, veering southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate, becoming rough later.

Rain at times, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 6 or 7, increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Rain at times, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 7 to severe gale 9, veering west 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first offshore.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high later.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 7 to severe gale 9, veering west or northwest 5 to 7 later.

Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough later in east.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high later in west.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering west gale 8 to storm 10, veering northwest 5 to 7 later.  
Very rough or high, occasionally very high at first in west, becoming moderate or rough later in north and east.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.  
Rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 6 to gale 8, becoming northwest 4 to 6.  
Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first in southwest, becoming moderate later.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6, backing north or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 to 6.  
Moderate, occasionally rough later in south.  
Rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6, backing north or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first in south.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, backing northwest 3 or 4, then veering north 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.  
Rain at times, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast 4 or 5, backing northwest 3 or 4, then veering north 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain at times.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast backing north 3 to 5, then veering northeast 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough in west.  
Rain at first, then showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East 4 or 5, backing northeast 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeast 6 to gale 8.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East 4 or 5, backing northeast 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeast 6 to gale 8.  
Rough or very rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
East to southeasterly flow will strengthen on Friday as low pressure extends east across the British Isles.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Southerly backing southeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in northwest at first  
Moderate

Occasional rain  
Moderate or good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 01 Nov until 0600 UTC on Saturday 02 Nov:

Southeast 4 or 5 backing east 5 to 7  
Moderate, becoming mainly rough later  
Occasional rain  
Moderate or good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 5 to 6, locally 4, backing south to southwest for a time during afternoon, increasing 6 to 7 during evening, and occasionally gale 8 with gusts to 50kt later overnight.

Slight to moderate increasing rather rough to rough by midnight, and increasing rough to very rough overnight.

Periods of rain and drizzle, locally heavy with mist and isolated fog patches, clearing to scattered showers late evening.

Moderate occasionally poor, locally very poor, improving moderate to good late evening.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest to west 7 to gale 8 with gust to 50kt, perhaps severe gale 9 mid-channel till early afternoon, decreasing 5 to 7 for a time around midnight.

Rough to very rough, increasing high mid-channel and northwest of area from mid-morning till dusk, decreasing rather rough to rough by dawn.

Scattered showers, occasionally heavy with a risk of thunder, showers more frequent later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

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
