Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Tuesday 02 June to 0000 UTC Wednesday 03 June 2015

General Situation

The unusually deep area of low pressure for early June over western Scotland will move away northeastwards and slowly fill with gales easing. By Wednesday, all areas will be in a much more gentle westerly airstream.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast becoming cyclonic, then west or northwest later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate in east.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in Moray Firth.

Moderate or rough, but slight in Moray Firth.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8 occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering west 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in northeast.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering west 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain then showers.

Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming slight.
Fair.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fair later.

Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight later.

Fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first, becoming slight later.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering west or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time.

Rain or drizzle, becoming fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first, becoming slight later.

Fair.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain or drizzle, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate east of the Lizard.

Fair.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain or drizzle, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, backing southwest later.

Moderate or rough.

Fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, backing southwest 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, backing south later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 6 or 7, veering west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 at first in north, veering westerly 5 to 7, then westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Very rough or high at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in east.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering westerly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in far north, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight, except in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West gale 8 to storm 10, decreasing 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.

Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming northwest, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, but rough in far north and in far south.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep low over the northern Scottish mainland will move northeast, reaching Norway early on Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Severe gale force 9 backing easterly and decreasing gale force 8 soon, issued 01/1548 GMT.

East or southeast 6 to gale 8 becoming cyclonic 5 or 6.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Jun:

Cyclonic 5 or 6 becoming northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to 7, locally gale 8 alderney and north, decreasing 5 to 7 by midday, veering westerly 4 to 6 by evening.

Rough, locally very rough mid-channel, decreasing rather rough to rough during the afternoon.

Occasional rain and drizzle clearing to fair Tuesday evening risk of coastal fog patches.

Moderate occasionally poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 4 to 5, locally 6 in the north at first, decreasing 2 to 4 by Wednesday afternoon, becoming variable 1 to 3 later.

Rather rough decreasing slight with a moderate swell.

Fair.
