General Situation

Low pressure over the near Continent will bring strong winds, fog patches and occasional rain to southern and eastern parts of the United Kingdom today. High pressure centred to the northwest of the United Kingdom will maintain largely fine and settle weather over the north and west.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Northerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near North Foreland, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near North Foreland.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure over the Faeroes and a low over Scandinavia will maintain a northerly airflow over Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

North 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first.

Moderate.

Mainly fair, but occasional drizzle in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Wednesday 01 Jun until 0600 UTC on Thursday 02 Jun:

North 5 or 6.

Moderate, becoming mainly rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North to northeast 4, occasionally 5, increasing 4 to 5 Thursday morning.

Slight to moderate, locally rather rough in the west and north overnight.

Misty with occasional light rain or drizzle risk of fog patches especially Wednesday night.

Moderate to poor, perhaps very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to north 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 Thursday evening.

Slight to moderate, locally rather rough in the north and west at first.

A little rain or drizzle at times risk of mist or fog patches.
