Forecast for Tuesday 01 Aug 2023

Weather: A rather cloudy start with patchy rain or drizzle in the south. Dry and brightening up in the north with a chance of sunny spells. Remaining cloudy across Skye and southern ranges with some patchy light rain or drizzle at times.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 40% at first soon becoming 80%.

Low cloud and visibility: Patchy cloud and fog above 500m at first, this soon dispersing then hills expected to be clear with good visibility.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Generally good conditions for hill walking but feeling rather warm on lower slopes in afternoon sunshine.

Forecast for Wednesday 02 Aug 2023

Weather: Mainly dry with clear spells overnight but some showers arriving into the north. A rather cloudy day in the north with a few showers but mostly dry and bright in the south and along the west coast. Cool and windy on the tops.

Maximum wind: North or NE 20 to 30mph gusts 40mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 70%.

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional low cloud and fog above 600m in the north and briefly poor in drizzly showers. Mainly good visibility further south.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 13C rising to 16C in north and 19C in south.

At 800m: Plus 8C rising to 12C.

Freezing level: Above the summits.
