General Situation

Low pressure to the west of Ireland will bring fairly moist, but also fairly gentle winds from a southerly quadrant over the next few days. Spells of rain or showers are likely at times, especially in the west and north, where some of the showers could turn thundery at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Slight, occasionally moderate later in far northwest.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 3 to 4, veering west to southwest around dawn, locally variable 2 across south of the area after midday veering west to northwest during the early evening, .

Slight locally smooth.

Isolated showers mist patches and isolated fog patches forming after dark, mostly clearing by Sunday afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor after dark, perhaps very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 3 to 4 backing southwest by midnight, further backing south to southwest 4 to 5 by dawn and locally 6 in north of the area, veering southwest by afternoon.

Slight, becoming slight to moderate by midday, with a low swell.

Mist patches occasional light rain and drizzle spreading eastwards on Monday morning and clearing later.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor, mainly Monday morning.

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
