#### General Situation

Areas of low pressure will continue to move eastwards across the United Kingdom.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in east, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.

Squally showers.

Good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 for a time, then becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough in northwest, slight or moderate in east.

Showers.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near Rattray Head, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, veering northwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first in south.

Moderate or good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest, backing south or southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.

Fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.  
Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4, becoming variable 3, then becoming southeasterly 4 or 5,  
occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Rain or drizzle later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 6 to gale 8, veering northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming southerly or  
southeasterly 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Rain or drizzle later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming south or southeast  
5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in the solent.

Fair, then rain or drizzle.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable  
3 or less later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in far west, becoming slight  
in shelter.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Fair, then rain or drizzle at times.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, veering north or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4,  
becoming variable 3 or less later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in southwest, becoming

slight in shelter.  
Squally showers at first.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 4, increasing 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.  
Fair, then rain or drizzle at times.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly 6 to gale 8 at first in south, otherwise northerly or  
northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in north.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or southeasterly 5 to 7, veering southerly  
later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near St Davids Head.  
Fair, then rain or drizzle at times.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming east or  
southeast 5 to 7 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 at times, backing west 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3, then becoming east or southeast 4  
or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers, squally at times.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming east or southeast 5 to 7  
later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Showers, squally at times.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming east or southeast 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest, backing west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming east 5 to 7 later except near Ardnamurchan Point.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight in shelter.

Squally showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far north.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far north.

Squally showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, decreasing 3 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in southwest.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in southwest.

Squally showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

## Shetland Isles

### General Situation

Complex low pressure southeast of Shetland moves into Scandinavia with a strong cold northerly airstream affecting Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Northerly gale force 8 expected soon. Issued 2153 UTC on Sunday 02 December 2018.

Northerly 5 to 7, but cyclonic 4 at first in far southeast.

Moderate at first in southeast, otherwise rough, but becoming very rough later in north. remaining slight to moderate close to east Shetland coast.

Showers, wintry later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 03 Dec until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 04 Dec:

Northerly backing northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 in west later.

Rough, occasionally very rough in north and east, but moderate in sheltered waters near south and east Shetland coast.

Wintry showers.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

### Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west, 5 to 6, occasionally 7, increasing 6 to 7 by midday, locally gale 8 mid channel, veering northwest 3 to 5 overnight, locally variable 2 to 3 around dawn.

Rather rough to rough, occasionally very rough mid channel around midday, decreasing to moderate to rather rough in the evening, then slight by dawn Tuesday.

Scattered showers, locally heavy, becoming isolated by midday.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor with showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northwest 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 at first, becoming southeasterly 2 to 4 by midday, increasing 4 to 5 by evening, veering south to southwest 5 to 6 by midnight, perhaps locally 7 mid-channel by dawn.

Slight with swell, increasing moderate to rather rough during the evening.

Isolated showers dying out during the morning rain spreading in from the west Tuesday afternoon, with mist patches overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers or rain, poor with mist.

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
