Forecast for Monday 05 Dec 2022

Weather: Mostly cloudy, but a few clear spells in west overnight and some brighter interludes during the day, but more especially in the west. Some showers, these wintry on the tops, above around 500m, but most in the east and north, however there could longer spells of rain and summit snow in the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 60% in west, 30% in east

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility, but moderate or poor in showers, though very poor in snow showers and within cloud with areas of cloud above 700m, but bases down to 500m in showers and this quite often in north and east.

Meteorologist's View

Rather cold on the summits with some chill effect, especially in wintry showers.

Forecast for Tuesday 06 Dec 2022

Weather: A few clear spells overnight with a frost in places. Then a rather cold, but mostly cloudy day with showers, these wintry above 300 or 400m, but most will be over the north and east and tending to fade away through the morning with some bright or perhaps sunny spells breaking through. A significant chill effect at height.

Maximum wind: Northeast 15mph, but 25 gust 35mph at height in showers

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 70%, but closer to 30% in east in morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility but moderate in rain showers and very poor in snow showers and within cloud with bases quite widespread down to 500m at first in east, otherwise occasionally broken above 700 or 800m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Zero C rising to plus 5 C
At 600m: Minus 1 C
Freezing level: 500m
