Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Friday 04 June to 1800 UTC Saturday 05 June 2021

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure gradually displaces heavy rain to the east of the United Kingdom tonight. Weak fronts will encroach from off the Atlantic and become the focus for some rain or showers into the weekend.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

##### 24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5 at first near Cape Wrath and Rattray Head, otherwise variable 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north, becoming smooth or slight later in east. Showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 4 or 5 for a time.

Moderate west and north of Orkney, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

##### 24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mostly south or southeast at first, 3 or 4, becoming west 4 or 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

##### 24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight, becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly south or southeast at first, 2 to 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

##### 24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain at first, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, veering north or northeast later, 3 or 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain at first, fog patches later in north.

Moderate or poor, becoming moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly, backing southwesterly later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming variable, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming variable for a time, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 later, occasionally 5 later in far west.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate west of the Lizard peninsula.

Fair then occasional rain or drizzle with fog banks later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Mainly moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle with fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 in west, occasionally 5 later in west, otherwise variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in west.

Fair until later, then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 or 4 at first in west, otherwise variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Moderate at first in west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 in Cardigan Bay, otherwise south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near St Davids Head and Holyhead.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near St Davids Head.

Fair until later then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near Holyhead, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, with fog patches at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 north of Morecambe Bay, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 at first north of Morecambe Bay, otherwise variable, becoming northwesterly later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, with fog patches at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in west.

Slight.

Fair at first, occasional drizzle and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, veering northerly or northwesterly 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, veering northwesterly later in north, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight except in northwest.

Thundery showers later, fog patches later in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering northwesterly, then becoming variable later, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Thundery showers and fog patches at first in east, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in east, becoming good later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth in Firth of Clyde.

Mainly fair, fog patches and thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering northwesterly 3 to 5, then becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.

Thundery showers with fog patches, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South, veering west later, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in south.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming southwest later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight near Cape Wrath.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming southwest later, 2 to 4.

Moderate.

Rain or showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia will maintain a settled mainly south or southeasterly airflow over Shetland Waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

South or southwest 3 becoming variable 3 or less for time, then east 2 or 3 later

Slight

Fog patches

Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun until 1800 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun:

East or southeast 2 to 4

Slight, occasionally moderate in west later

Fog patches

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 3 to 4, becoming westerly 2 to 3 after dawn and occasionally variable from late morning.

Smooth, locally slight, with a low swell developing.

Fair or fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 1 to 3, occasionally variable.

Smooth, locally slight, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches in the north and west of the area after dawn.

Good, locally moderate to very poor after dawn.

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
