Weather: A dry day with varying amounts of cloud. Cloud most likely to shroud the summits across Caithness and Sutherland, and perhaps around the Great Glen at first.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 60%, best chance towards the southwest

Low cloud and visibility: Areas of cloud down to 700 to 900 metres, otherwise very good visibility outside of cloud

Forecast for Saturday 04 Mar 2023

Weather: A few wintry showers expected across North Highland where it will be cloudy for most of the day. A lot of dry weather expected across Skye, Lochaber and around the Great Glen with the chance of clearer skies and some sunshine although cloud is likely to invade the summits from the north through the afternoon

Maximum wind: Northerly 15 mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 50%. Best chance in the southwest

Low cloud and visibility: Areas of cloud down to 700 to 900 metres in the north of the area throughout the day, patches down to 300 metres on some upslopes in the northwest at first. Very good underneath the cloud sheet

Temperature: **Glens:** -3 rising to 8 Celsius
At 800m: Minus 1 Celsius
Freezing level: 600 rising to 900 metres
